Carroll Edmond Sharpe, Sr., 93, died Saturday February 22, at Steadman Hill at Asbury Place in Kingsport, TN. He spent all of his life in Wise County, mostly in Roda, Virginia.

Carroll proudly served in the US Navy for four years during the Korean Conflict.

For over 40 years, "Shag" worked for Westmoreland Coal Company at several of their underground mines.

He was preceded in death by his wife of 73 years, Barbara Jean Markland Sharpe; his parents, Charlie and Nora Potter Sharpe; brothers Cecil Sharpe, McLynn Sharpe, Bruce Sharpe, Eugene Sharpe and sister, Thelma Sharpe Sergeant.
