



Faye Evelyn LeBlanc

July 30, 1938 - July 23, 2019

Faye Evelyn Jackson LeBlanc, 80 of Appalachia, passed away July 23, 2019 at the hospital. Through her declining health, Faye was able to maintain her independent life with the assistance of her siblings, Barbara Sue and Bryan. She was born in Wise County, VA on December 7, 1938, the oldest child of William Curtis Jackson and Ruth Mumpower Jackson. After high school graduation, Faye explored life in various southern cities as an independent young woman until a stranger asked her to dance at a YMCA social in Knoxville, TN. Faye would marry the stranger, Ralph Leger LeBlanc on October 8, 1960. The two were married for 54 years until his death on March 17, 2015.

As a modern working woman, Faye's career spanned more than five decades finishing with retirement from United Central. She was a member of the Order of Eastern Star Appalachia Chapter No. 26, Professional Secretaries International, United Methodist Woman, and Modern Woodman where she served as Activities Coordinator. Faye was a member of the Appalachia United Methodist Church where she found comfort and support after the death of her husband. She could often be found in the kitchen cooking for her family. Faye was preceded in death by her parents, William Curtis Jackson and Ruth Elizabeth Mumpower Jackson and brother, William C. Jackson.

She is survived by daughter, Pamela LeBlanc Swiney and husband, Rodney

W. Swiney; two grandsons, Caleb Leger Swiney and Micah Walker Swiney of Dallas, GA; three siblings, Barbara Sue Walters and husband, Dr. Gary Walters of Johnson City, TN, Robert Jackson, Sr. of Troy, NC, and Bryan M.
