After 35 years of service, Paul retired from Norfolk-Southern Railroad. He was named "Peg" by his coworkers. He served as veteran of foreign wars in the United States Air Force for 4 years where he was assigned to the occupation and rebuilding of Germany during the outbreak of the Korean War.
